

## THE DEADLIEST PLACES TO GROCERY SHOP IN AMERICA

Between January 1, 2020 and March 20, 2024, there were **702 incidents of gun violence** in America's largest grocery store chains, based on our analysis of data from [Gun Violence Archive](#). These incidents remind Americans across the country that we put our lives in danger any time we go out to buy food. We're calling on the nation's leading supermarket chains to do their part to help build a future with fewer guns and safer communities.
